Grimmfest is officially 10 years old! To celebrate, we're bringing you our biggest ever selection of European, UK and Regional Premieres.

Guest of honour is genre legend Barbara Crampton, who will open the festival with a special screening of Stuart Gordon's cult classic RE-ANIMATOR.

We're also delighted to be welcoming back a number of talented filmmakers who've shared their work with us over the past decade. Rob Grant (FAKE BLOOD, MON AMI) presents the outrageous shocker, ALIVE. Johnny Kevorkian (THE DISAPPEARED), returns with AWAIT FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS. 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



CREEPED OUT is a CBBC family/ kids horror anthology; a series of self-contained tales, all linked by the character of 'The Curious', a mysterious story collector, who bookends each episode. Recalling some of the classic creepy Children's TV of the 1970s, and aligning itself to a rich tradition of sour, supernaturally-themed moral tales, ranging from Roald Dahl to EC Comics, the show's appeal extends far beyond its young audience. Directors on the series include Bruce McDonald (PONTYPOOL, HELLIONS) and adult fans include GHOST STORIES' Andy Nyman. Season 2 is currently being shot in Canada and the Northwest of the UK.

In this special family-friendly preview event, Grimmfest welcomes co-creators and show runners Bede Blake and Robert Butler, who will choose their favourite UK and favourite Canadian episode from Season One and, if we are lucky, share an insight into what's in store for the new series. A medical student and his girlfriend become involved in a bizarre experiment into reanimating the dead...

Stuart Gordon's baroque, blackly comic re-imagining of H.P. Lovecraft's bizarro pulp novella Frankenstein, HERBERT WEST, REANIMATOR, is rightly acknowledged as a genre classic. The source material was weird and wild enough to begin with, but Gordon amps

it up into ghoulish, gory farce, filled with outrageous and perverse scenes and characters, and confrontational and controversial content, that has attracted the censor's scissors more than once. But fear not folks, this is the original unrated version of this corpse-strewn cult comedy classic, which made stars of both Jeffrey Combs and Grimmfest 2018's guest of honour Barbara Crampton - who will introduce the screening.

A dysfunctional family awake on Christmas morning to discover they're sealed inside their house by a mysterious black substance. On television, a single line of text reads: "Stay Indoors and Await Further Instructions."

A classic domestic lock-down drama in the manner of RIGHT AT YOUR DOOR and WHAT WE BECOME, AWAIT FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS dials up the tension by setting the action during that most fraught and awkward of situations, the British Suburban Family Christmas. The university-educated son and his Asian girlfriend, the horrible racist Grandad,

the control freak father, the simpering doormat of a mother, the chav sister and her meathead boyfriend: it's a guestlist guaranteed to get confrontational without any external pressures. But once the action starts, things get... ugly. There's a fairly clear satiric intent here, if you want it; a comment on the current climate of paranoid insularity, post-Brexit, with the sealed-up house reflecting British society in miniature. Then, just when you think you have a handle on the film's intentions, things take a turn for the plain... strange. Prepare to be mind-blown.



All girl volleyball team The Falcons end up stranded in the middle of nowhere after their mini-van breaks down.
Little do they know they have landed in degenerate hunters' territory and the hunt is on. But the girls are more resourceful than it appears. In the heart of the forest, the tables are about to turn between hunter and hunted...

You'd think people in movies would have learned not to follow the crude hand-painted "Diversion" sign off the main road and into the woods by now, wouldn't you? Sure, this is rural France, not the Appalachians, but insane cannibal hillbillies are the same the world

over. Referencing such recent Gallic bloodbaths as FRONTIER(S) and THE PACK, but plundering and parodying backwoods hunter-killer tropes in general, this broad, bawdy, bloody black comedy offers a slyly feminist reinvention of the perennially-popular "Cheerleaders in Peril" scenario of countless catchpenny 80s slasher movies. Boasting a strong message of female empowerment and sisterhood, it's a real crowdpleaser, with the talented, young, and mainly female cast proving more than a match for French cinema legend, and inveterate scene-stealer, Denis Lavant's leering cannibal patriarch. Goooooo, Falcons!







At the world's leading arms manufacturer, Ammotech, the board of directors decides to test a new energy drink on their staff to see if it boosts efficiency. But the drink has a few unforeseen side effects – such as turning everyone who drinks it into a hyper-aggressive homicidal maniac...

If Mike Judge and George Romero had ever teamed up to make a satire of modern office politics, the end result might have played a little like this. Starting out as a deadpan slacker comedy chronicling the day to day grind of life as a white-collar grunt-worker in an open-plan corporate hell-hole, it quickly morphs into a ferociously violent struggle for survival,

once the weaponised energy drink kicks in, unleashing all of the twisted ambitions, peer envy and plain craziness lurking just below the surface in any office culture. Ian Shorr and Peter Gamble's script offers some inventively witty as well as genuinely disturbing manifestations of workplacebased insanity, and finds plenty of time for sly digs at the US corporate mindset, the Arms Trade, and American cultural and racial insensitivity, while director Lin Oeding's early background in stunt direction is evident in the panache and dynamism with which the action scenes are handled. Couple that with pitch-perfect performances from a strong cast, and this is likely to be the best day you're going to have in any office this year.

A caring mother loses her grip on sanity during one terrifying night in the woods.

This one has it all, and then some. It's a wild and genuinely unpredictable ride; splicing together EVIL DEAD style cabin in the woods antics with folk horror, pagan ritual and witchcraft with political satire, arcane conspiracies with gory axekillings, and framing it all within a dual-timeline narrative structure, pastiching one of those lurid and bombastic true crime shows so beloved of US TV, and contrasting the actual events with how

they were reported later. Even though we know almost from the start what will happen (or think we do!), the whys and wherefores remain obscure and the film's breakneck pace and unexpected switches in tone and focus will keep you guessing and wondering to the end. With a top cast headed by Barbara Crampton and AJ Bowen, this is an off-kilter, bloody, and darkly humorous study in family dysfunction, religious hypocrisy and media manipulation that you won't forget in a hurry.

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
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# TIGERS ARE NOT AFRAID (VUELVEN)

A Mexican City turned into a ghost town by the drug-war. When 11-year-old Estrella's mother vanishes, she makes a wish: she wants her mother to come back. And mom does return—from the dead. Terrified, Estrella escapes and joins a rag-tag gang of other children orphaned by the violence, all escaping their own past. But she learns that in a city ruled by death, you can't simply leave the ghosts behind; they walk with you wherever you go.

Championed by Guillermo del Toro as one of the finest films of the year, Issa López's astonishing, multi-award-winning urban fairy tale offers perhaps a glimpse of the road del Toro himself didn't take; focusing more on gritty social realism, and keeping the more fantastic elements in the background. The end result is a kind of Magic Realist reimagining of the Héctor Brabenco classic, PIXOTE, deftly incorporating fairy tale tropes into harrowing and brutal reality. Here, the Lost Boys are homeless kids, the ogres they face are drug-dealers, pimps and sex traffickers, and the only magic is that of a child's imagination. Bold, strong, emotive filmmaking, with real heart, this one will haunt your dreams.

After suspecting that their police officer neighbour is a serial killer, a group of teenage friends spend their summer spying on him and gathering evidence, but as they get closer to discovering the truth, things get dangerous.

The directors of TURBO KID continue their obsession with all things 80s, with a film guaranteed to evoke fond childhood memories for anyone who grew up in that decade. Paying deft homage to such much-loved classics as STAND BY ME, or THE GOONIES, in its narrative of a mismatched quartet of 15 year old boys getting involved in crime during a

Summer holiday, while bickering among one another and mooning over girls, this is nevertheless no mere exercise in misty-eyed nostalgia, or cynical cash-in pastiche. Refreshingly free from post-modern rib-nudging and smugly ironic historical perspective, it offers instead a clear-eyed and surprisingly merciless examination of the often rose-tinted recollections of childhood. And in that respect, more than any other, it really does recapture the spirit of the films it references. A trip down memory lane that will take you to places you'd possibly rather forget.







With their Mother dying of cancer, two brothers go to extreme lengths to protect their inheritance from being signed away.

Introducing Clayton and Shane Jacobson, Australia's answer to the Coen Brothers. Clayton writes and directs, Shane produces, and they both star, in this pitch-black tragicomedy of squabbling siblings, filial ingratitude, thwarted ambition, broken dreams and brutal murder. By turns hilariously funny and shockingly savage, the film never

loses sight of its characters' essential humanity, however flawed and fallible, and manages the shifting, darkening tone from laconic, deadpan humour, through noirish betrayal, to ultimate tragedy with dazzling skill. Oh, and it has some of the best dialogue of any film this year; the brothers' onscreen double act benefiting enormously from their real life relationship... although we can only hope that they weren't drawing too closely on autobiographical material for the rest of the film.

A man kisses his wife and baby goodbye and seemingly heads away on business, with a plan to check into a hotel, call an escort service, and kill an unsuspecting prostitute.

Nicolas Pesce's follow-up to the gritty and ferocious rural backwoods gothic of THE EYES OF MY MOTHER couldn't really be more different. An adaptation of the confrontational cult novel by Japanese literary provocateur Ryû Murakami, it spins its sulphurous source

material into a kind of perverse rom-com; urban, urbane, and utterly pitiless, a sly and satiric study in the social mores of S&M, and Cronenbergian body-horror, set in an elegantly artificial retro-80s world, all shiny surfaces and double-breasted silver-grey suits. Elegantly witty and uncomfortably erotic, boasting a carefully-constructed score culled from classic gialli, and pitch-perfect performances from Mia Wasikowska and Christopher Abbott, it's the perfect date movie for psychopaths.



JUAN OF THE DEAD director Alejandro Brugués deconstructs and demolishes that Cabin In The Woods set-up once and for all. Japanese maestro of mayhem Ryûhei Kitamura contributes a characteristically gory and confrontational tale of possession in a Catholic School. 100 DAYS OF NIGHT's David Slade unleashes a nightmare in black and white, while Garris himself offers a chilling meditation on maternal love. Something for everyone, in other words... Whether they like it or not.



When Simon brings his twelve year-old son, Finn, to rural Vermont to help flip an old farmhouse, they encounter the malicious spirit of Lydia, a previous owner. And now with every repair they make - she's getting stronger.

Home, they say, is where the heart is... Recalling the work of Thomas Tryon in its rural country-gothic setting, and Stephen King in its dysfunctional family dynamics and use of the supernatural to offset and heighten the narrative's true emotional focus, this is both a subtly creepy ghost story and a quietly devastating study of a flawed father's relationship with his son, and his desire to rebuild a family and a home. Taking time to establish the characters and involve the viewer in their situation, the film gradually ratchets up the tension, both supernatural and emotional, building to a climax that is both nightmarish and genuinely heartbreaking.

When Edgar finds a nefarious looking puppet in his deceased brother's room, he decides to sell the doll for some quick cash at a small town convention. All hell breaks loose when a strange force animates the puppets at the convention, setting them on a bloody killing spree, motivated by an evil as old as time.

PUPPET MASTER is back! Even in our current era of Eighties-fixated retro-ism, this one still raised a sceptical eyebrow or two when first announced. Charles Band's much-loved trash-cult classic given a big-budget makeover? No way! But we needn't have worried. Exec-Produced by Band himself, in association with Fangoria Magazine, this is a real labour of love, both for the franchise itself, and for the era that spawned it.

Scandinavian shock-stylists Sonny Laguna and Tommy Wiklund capture perfectly the look and feel of 80s horror, with its plasticky colour-palette, garish and grisly practical gore effects, casually gratuitous nudity, and eclectic casts of hardboiled cops and hapless nerds. S. Craig Zahler's script crackles with knowing wit, delivering likeable characters, sharp dialogue, outrageous deaths, and, as one might expect from the writer-director of BONE TOMAHAWK, a surprising amount of cruelty. The end result is a blistering B-Picture homage with A-list credentials, and an A-list cast, headed by Grimmfest quest of honour Barbara Crampton. The soundtrack, by the legendary Fabio Frizzi, is just icing on the cake. Why not indulge yourselves?

Taking inspiration from the obscure 1982 Sisworo Gautama Putra film SATAN'S SLAVE, which he claims first inspired him to be a director, Anwar's loose prequel-remake draws, surprisingly respectfully, on rural Indonesian folklore and religious beliefs, as well as on his own deft mastery of genre cinema's big bag of audio-visual techniques and trickery, to spin an emotive, nerve-jangling, and complex tale of bad mothers, demonic children, strained family loyalties, the unquiet dead... and Satan's cunning and elaborate plan for world domination.

If you discovered a creepy, heavilydisfigured young woman in your apartment, brandishing a large dead rat, would you invite her to stay for dinner? Well, in that case, you only have yourself to blame for what follows... Expanding on their original short of the same name, Director Jon Knautz and Writer-Star Alexis Kendra's black-hearted fable is a

ruthlessly uncomfortable exploration of sexual and gender politics, aspiration and obsession. With its candy-coloured Californian suburban setting, stylised, larger-than-life characters, and sudden, shocking tonal shifts between darkly comic and deeply disturbing, it plays like an episode of DESPERATE HOUSEWIVES written by Ryû Murakami, with Rachel Alig giving a genuinely terrifying performance in the title role; her quiet, almost monotone delivery and eerie stillness a chilling contrast to her sudden bursts of hysterical possessiveness and brutal violence. Loneliness can be a terrible thing. But the wrong choice of friendship can be far worse.

Say what you will about Grimmfest regular Rob Grant; he likes to keep things unpredictable. Following the laconic, gore-soaked pitch-black buddy comedy, MON AMI, and last year's all-too-unnervingly real-seeming festival favourite FAKE BLOOD, he's back with something equally unexpected. Playing initially like a particularly left-field entry in the SAW franchise, with its injured

amnesiac protagonists locked in a battle of wills and survival with a mysterious tormentor who seems to know all about them, it quickly shifts gear into something far richer and stranger, as it works its way towards an utterly jaw-dropping final reveal. Tense, creepy, darkly funny, and quite spectacularly gory in places, with a truly baroque performance from Angus Macfadyen, simultaneously camply comedic and genuinely terrifying as the heroes' mysterious tormentor, this offbeat gem cements Rob Grant's reputation of one of genre cinema's true mavericks of morbid mischief. We can't wait to see how he follows this one...

## THE DEVIL'S DOORWAY

In the fall of 1960, Father Thomas Riley and Father John Thornton were sent by the Vatican to investigate a miraculous event in an Irish home for 'fallen women', only to uncover something much more horrific...

A found-footage film about a couple of priests sent by the Vatican to investigate a possible miracle... The bare-bones synopsis might suggest something akin to previous Grimmfest hit THE BORDERLANDS, but don't be fooled. You haven't seen anything like this before. The first found footage periodpiece, ostensibly compiled later from 16mm film footage recorded by one of the priests during the investigation. Offering both an icy study in religious

hypocrisy and fanaticism, and a terrifying tale of madness and possession, it draws on some of the more horrific crimes committed by the Catholic Church in Ireland, such as the infamous Magdalene Laundries and in particular Tuam Orphanage in Galway, with its mass grave of children's bodies, to ground its narrative in chillingly plausible reality. Dealing intelligently with issues of faith and doubt, and with the ugly doublestandards of Irish Catholicism, with regard to women and sexuality, this is a smart, suffocatingly claustrophobic, and genuinely troubling movie, that for once finds a good use for the faux-authenticity and immediacy afforded by the foundfootage subgenre. It all feels, disturbingly, very real.



William has a simple job: he makes dead bodies disappear. His little farm house in the country has become a dumping ground for the casualties of the gang related murders in the nearby city. His daughter Gloria has become used to corpses being dropped off at the house and is even convinced that some of them are haunting the place. And then a woman is dropped off who proves to be still alive...

There are some ghosts that you can't lay to rest... Chad Archibald, director of the ANTISOCIAL films, makes a welcome return to Grimmfest with something very different: A low-key rural-gothic crime

drama with supernatural elements. A sulphurous study of quilt and redemption, of good men forced to do bad things just to hold onto what they have, of innocence and decency surviving in the face of unspeakable horror, it recalls the early novels of David Morrell, and has the starkness, deceptive simplicity and rich character interplay of a classic Budd Boetticher Western. Beautifully shot, making great use of its wintery landscape and isolated farm location, and anchored by a remarkable performance from young Ava Preston as Gloria, it's a film that manages to remain genuinely surprising and unpredictable, even as it builds up to the inevitable final, fatal confrontation.

A zombie apocalypse threatens the sleepy town of Little Haven - at Christmas - forcing Anna and her friends to fight, slash and sing their way to survival, facing the undead in a desperate race to reach their loved ones. But they soon discover that no one is safe in this new world, and with civilization falling apart around them, the only people they can truly rely on are each other.

It's exactly what it says on the tin – a Scottish Christmas High School Zombie Musical. A seasonal shocker with songs, taking its cues as much from GLEE and HIGH SCHOOL MUSICAL as from the classic BUFFY THE VAMPIRE SLAYER episode "Once More With Feeling",

but filtering its John Hughes-style teenangst through the rather less glossy homegrown high school environment of GRANGE HILL, and adopting a lowkey, laconic, and very British - or more accurately Scottish - attitude to the walking dead, reminiscent of such nativegrown zom-com classics as SHAUN OF THE DEAD and COCKNEYS VS ZOMBIES. With a star making turn from Ella Hunt as the eponymous Anna, and sterling support from TV comedy stalwarts Mark Benton and Paul Kaye, this bloody festive bauble looks set to become as much a part of the traditional British Christmas as Morecambe and Wise, Dr Who and the German Market.
